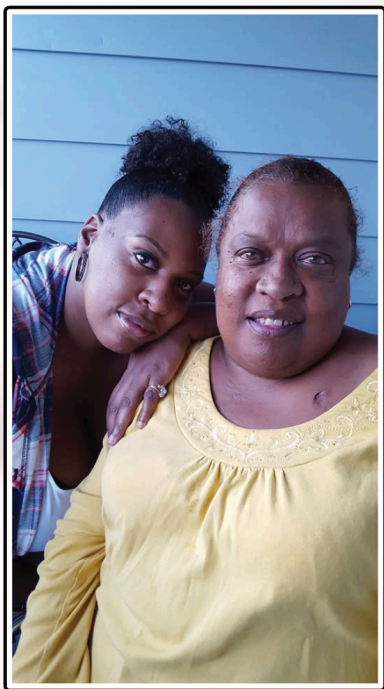
She will always be remembered for her kindness, compassion and beautiful spirit that touched countless lives.
