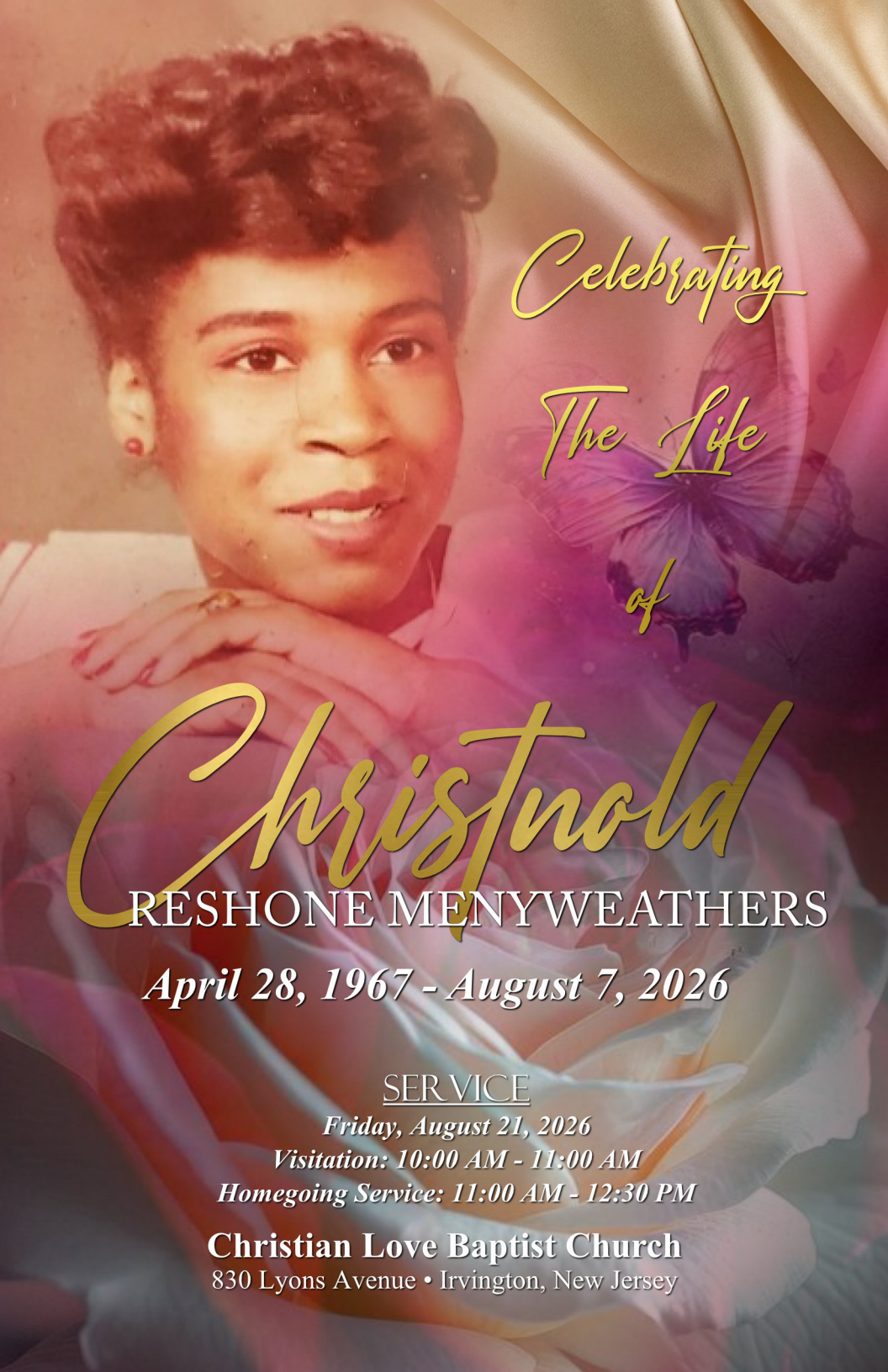

REFLECTION OF LIFE

Christnold Reshone Menyweathers was born on April 28, 1967, in Newark, New Jersey, to Christine Menyweathers and James R. Richardson. She was the youngest of six children.

Christnold began her education at Miller Street School in Newark, New Jersey. In 1973, she continued her education at Clinton Avenue School. She later attended Bergen Street School for middle and junior high school before attending Malcolm X Shabazz High School (Formerly South Side) Home of the Bulldogs in Newark. She graduated in the Class of '85

In 1983, Christnold began working at A&P Supermarket in Newark. Throughout her life, she held various positions and later dedicated more than 20 years of service to Dufry Tax and Duty Free at Newark International Airport. She remained there until October 2020, when she became ill and retired.
