Tonya wore many hats throughout her life, but the one she wore best was simply being Tonya.

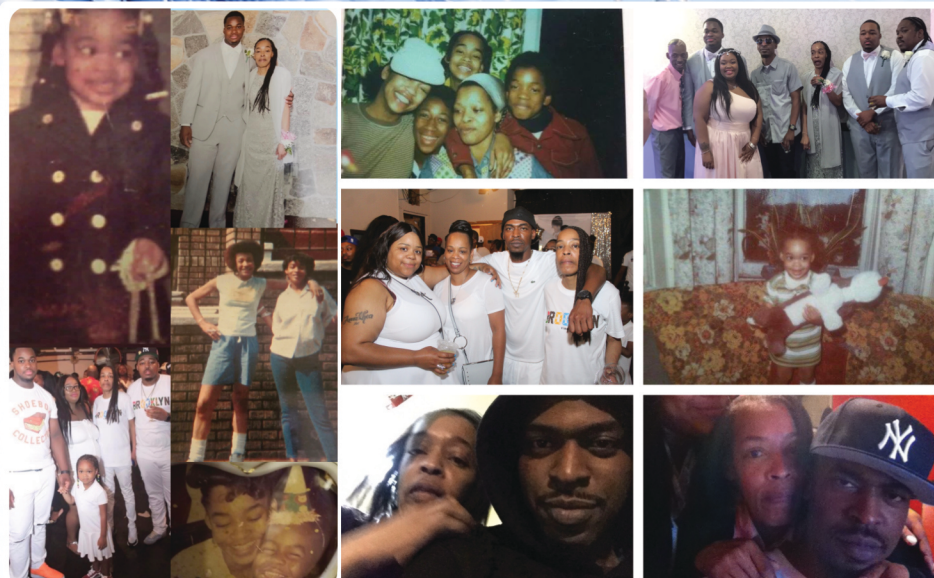
Because Tonya gave her family and friends memories worth laughing about, stories worth telling, and love worth holding onto.
