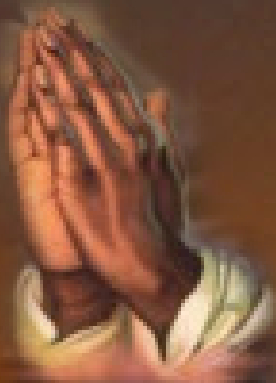

Obituary



Wilbur Howard Bailey, 75, of Edison, New Jersey passed away Monday June 7, from natural causes.

He was born the seventh of ten children to the late Andrew and Georgia Bailey, January 28, 1935 in Orange, New Jersey.

He graduated from Orange High School in 1953. He also attended the Northeastern Bible College where he became a licensed minister. Howard was married in 1965 to the late Gladys Pearl Sanders and they lived together in East Orange.

In his youth he ran track, played basketball, and football. And in his early 20's he became a member of the Gents Social Club. He entered the work-force as an insurance salesman for Equitable and Prudential insurance companies. Howard's career-path took a turn, when he secured a position with Amerada Hess Corporation as a desk dispatcher in 1972. There he worked for over 24 years, until he retired in 1996. After retiring he continued to stay busy by working for a few years as a driver for Hopewell Transportation, Valet & Limousine service. Howard volunteered his time with various organizations, and worked selflessly in his calling. He and his wife established the How-Glad Ministry, which was established as means to reach out to believers and non-believers in an effort to spread the Word of God. For many years Howard served as a deacon with Ebenezer Baptist Church in Orange, New Jersey and coached a very successful youth basketball team. After many years as a member of Ebenezer Baptist Church, the Lord led him to become a member of Bethlehem Baptist Church in Newark, New Jersey. There, he continued his fervor for serving God's people. In his spare time he was an avid participant and spectator of sports such as; bowling, basketball, and tennis.

He is survived by: two sons and two daughters-in law, Reginald Bailey of Clarksville Tennessee; Pamela Bailey of Fayetteville, North Carolina; Martin and Monica Bailey of Columbia, South Carolina; a grandchild, Che'Vonne Bailey of Fayetteville, North Carolina; two brothers, Andrew Bailey Jr. of East Orange, New Jersey and Karim Sabur of Kinoshah, Wisconsin; two sisters, Catherine Williams of Owings Mills, Maryland and Delores Banks of Avenel, New Jersey; and a host of nieces and nephews.

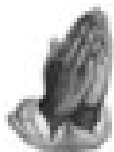

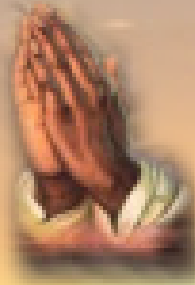
