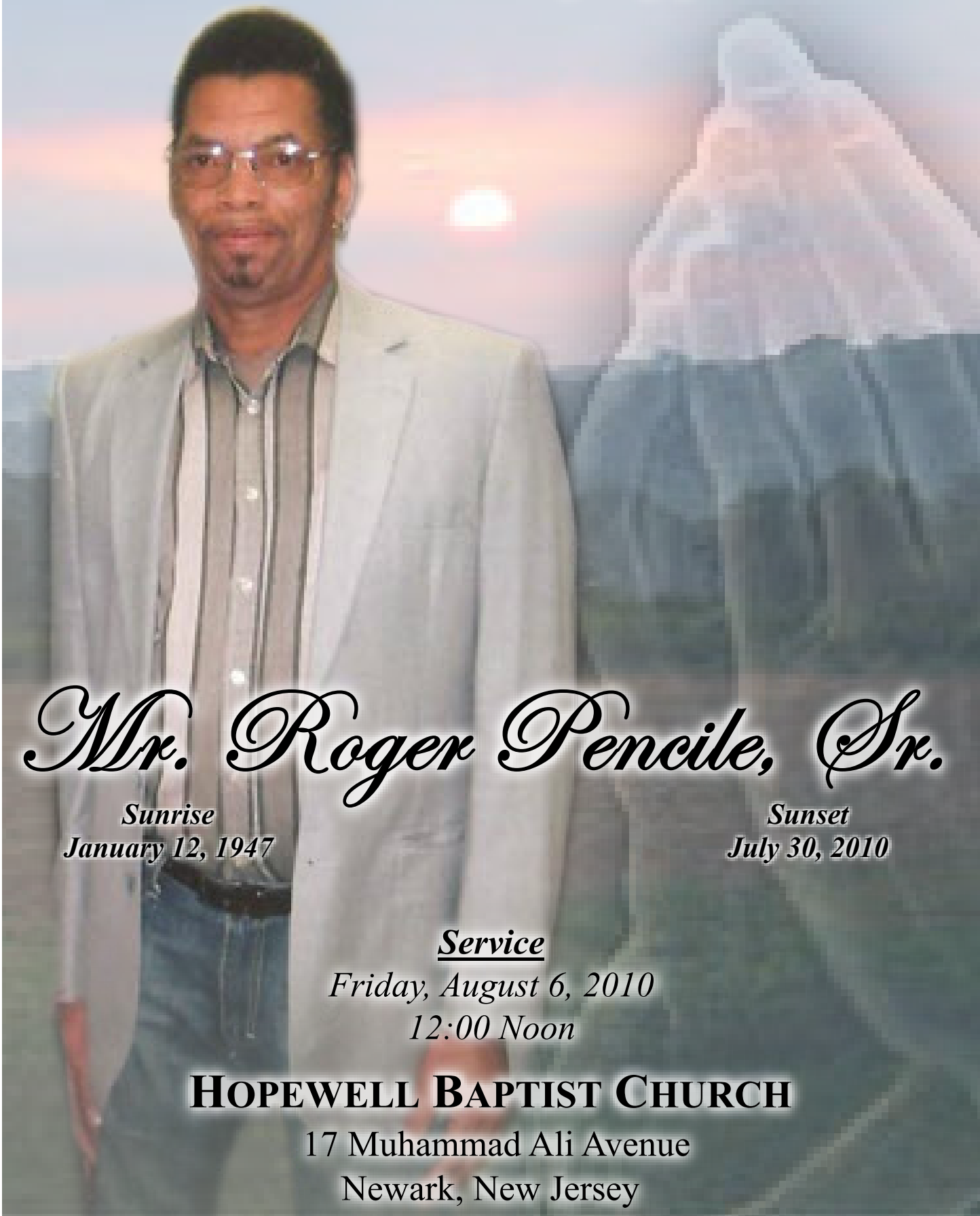

Roger grew up in the Yemassee Community of Colleton County, he attended the public school system of Colleton County, SC.

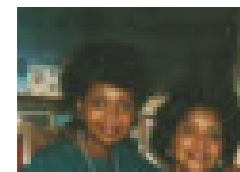
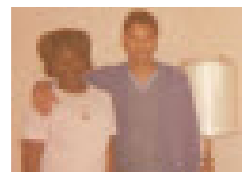
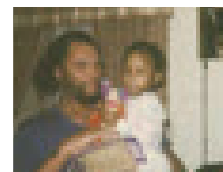
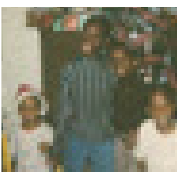
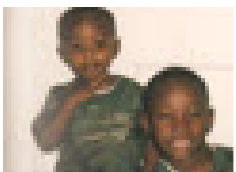
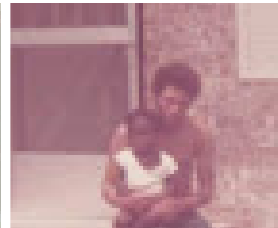
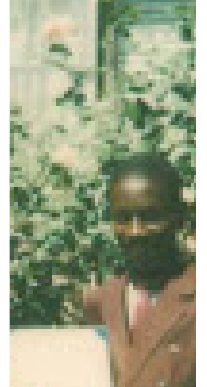
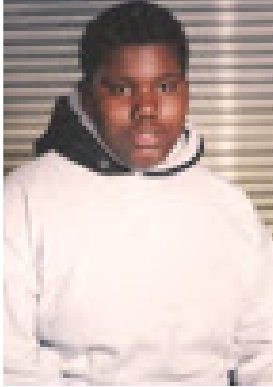

Dear Granddad

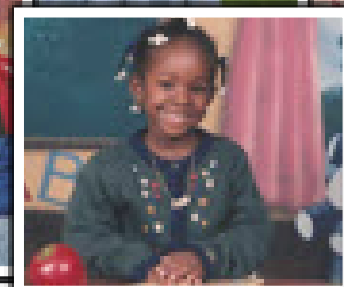
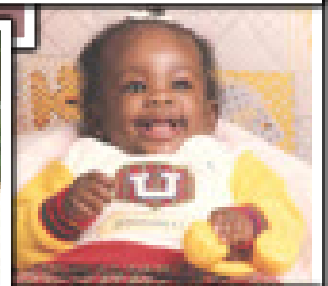
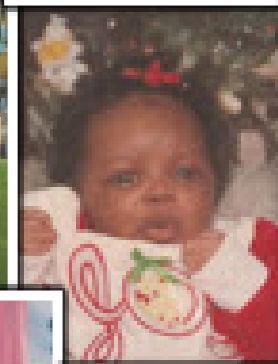
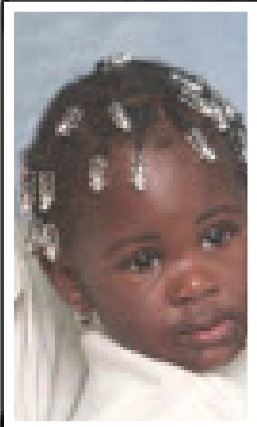
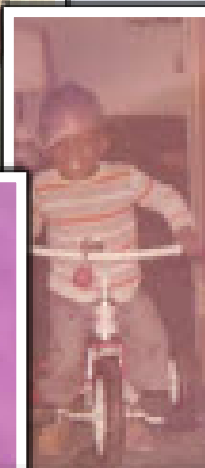
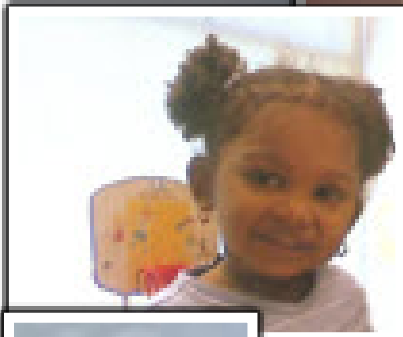
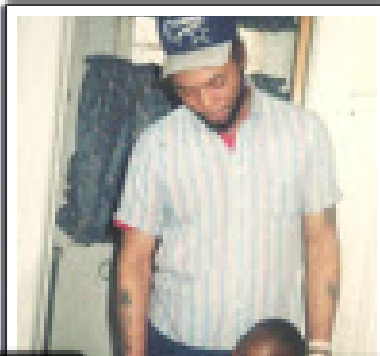
