

<u>Obituary</u>

Clyde Edmonds died at home on August 1, 2013. He was born in Cleveland, Ohio son of Edith Rose Edmonds and Emmett Douglas Edmonds.

His early childhood years were spent in Richmond, VA before moving to Washington, DC where he graduated from Dunbar High School in 1943. After entering West Virginia State University, Clyde was drafted into the US Army and served during the Korean War. He graduated from West Virginia State University in 1956 and studied at the Fels Institute of the University of Pennsylvania. Clyde was awarded an M.G.A in 1959.
