Odessa Curvy (nee Pinckney) was born August 3, 1917 in McCormick County, South Carolina. She was the last of seven siblings.

Odessa was raised in Youngstown, Ohio and Paterson, NJ. She graduated Eastside High in Paterson and then moved back to Youngstown where she attended Butler Memorial Presbyterian Church as a member for 34 years.

She then moved back to Paterson in 1963, attended St. Augustine Presbyterian Church where she served as Deacon and Secretary and also very active in YWCA as State Level Treasurer. She served as Secretary of the Federation Apartments Tenants Association where she resided for almost 40 years.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Charles Curvy.
