
Celebration of Life for Deacon Marshall Pridgen, Jr.

Deacon Marshall was educated in the Sampson County School System. At an early age, he left North Carolina and relocated to Newburgh, NY. He a Veteran of the United States Army. After living in Newburgh for several years, Deacon Marshall subsequently relocated to Paterson, NJ where he worked as a Clothing Presser in Fair Lawn, NJ. He also worked as a cook with the White Castle Company in Clifton, NJ over 20 years before retiring in 1995. He joined the Mt. Zion Baptist Church, Passaic, NJ and was a faithful member while his health permitted. He was an avid Bible reader, member of the Deacon Board, Sunday School Teacher and Superintendent of the Sunday School.





He was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers - John Albert Pridgen and Chevis Pridgen; three sisters - Ruth "Sister" Culbreth, Shirley Sampson and Katie Dell Butler.

On Friday, August 4, 2017, he entered into eternal rest at his home with his family by his side.
