Reverend Dr. Leora Liggins was born and reared in a Christian home in Millen, Georgia on November 8, 1937. She was the Blessed, and thankful daughter of the late Mr. James and Della Mitchell. At the age of 11, she accepted Christ as her personal Savior, and joined Trinity Methodist Church in Millen. Dr. Liggins joined the Baptist Church in 1962 and was "Baptized" in Savannah Georgia in that same year. A faithful member of Imani Baptist Church of Christ, located in East Orange, New Jersey, she was called to preach by God and licensed to preach the gospel on June 26, 1994 by Rev. Moses Knott, Jr. and the official Ministry of Imani Baptist Church. She was appointed as one of the Associate Pastors of the ministerial staff. Upon the completion of her seminary studies under the pastorate of Rev. Knott, she was ordained on October 22, 2000. Rev. Dr. Leora Liggins became Pastor and Founder of Christ Resurrection Missionary Baptist Church by the Holy Spirit of God on March 31, 2002 (Easter Sunday), which is a mission Church for Christ, in the highways and the byways for souls to be saved.

She earned an Associate Degree in Sociology at Essex County College, A Bachelor of Arts Degree in Sociology and a Masters Degree in Vocational Rehabilitation Counseling at Seton Hall University in South Orange, NJ, a Masters Degree of Divinity from Drew University Theological School in May 2000 (cum laude), and a Doctorate of Theology Degree at Andersonville Theological Seminary in August 2008 (summa cum laude). She studied Christian Women Leadership, under the Billy Graham Study Team. She has also taught for six years at Essex County College as an Adjunct Professor.

Rev. Dr. Liggins retired after seventeen years as the Clinical Supervisor at UMDNJ (Now Rutgers)-UBHC-Extended Adult Partial Program in Newark. She worked in the Mental Health Profession for twenty-two years. She has served on several boards and received numerous Awards and Certifications of Recognition for Community Services.




