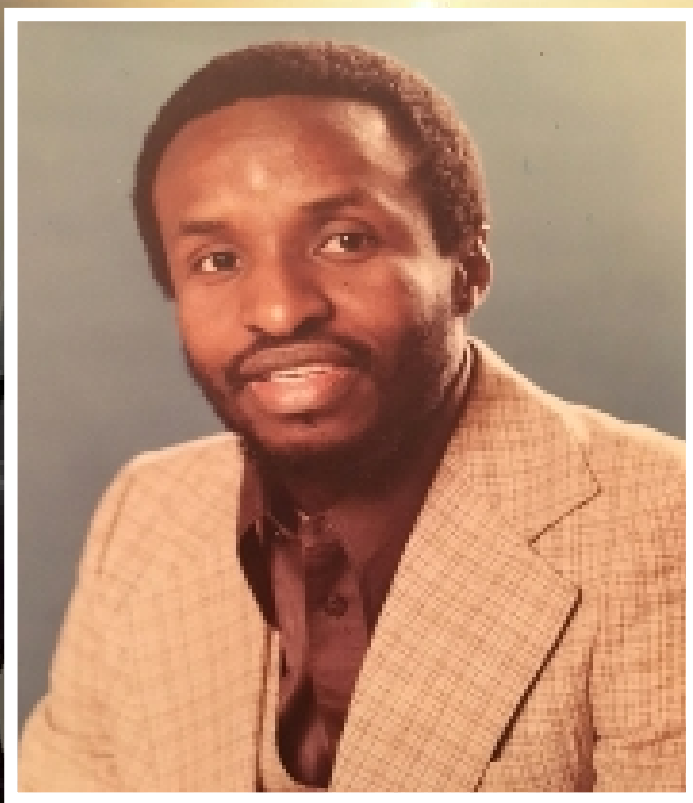

Cecil George Dinnall was born to Louise Smith and William Dinnall on June 13, 1942 in Kingston, Jamaica. Our Heavenly Father called him home on August 30, 2017 at Northwell LIJ hospital's hospice care unit in Valley Stream, New York.

As a young adult in his 20's he taught mathematics to grade-school children. He was also a performer and sang with a group in Jamaica. More importantly, his cousin taught him the dental trade and he served the communities of St. Clarendon, St. Thomas and other parishes. At the age of 24, he belonged to the Masonry lodge and served for two years before coming to the United States and landed in state of New York in 1969. He worked as a dental technician after receiving his certificate from the New York State School of Mechanical Dentistry in 1971.

In 1985, he received his Baccalaureate degree in Biochemistry and Biophysics from SUNY Plattsburgh.

In 2014, he gave his life to Christ and was later baptized at the Emanuel Baptist Church of Elmont, New York under the pastorate of Reverend Ralph P. Taylor. In 2015, he joined the church's Mens' Choir.

He leaves to cherish with memories: his wife Gloria, children; Faith Cecilia, Carlene Georgia, Annmarie Marjorie, Andrea Colleen, Andrew, Clive Devon and Michael Anthony, as well as 22 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren; his brother Clinton, sisters Shirley, Gurdilyn, Monica, Minel and Carol. And a host of cousins, nieces, nephews and other relatives and friends.
