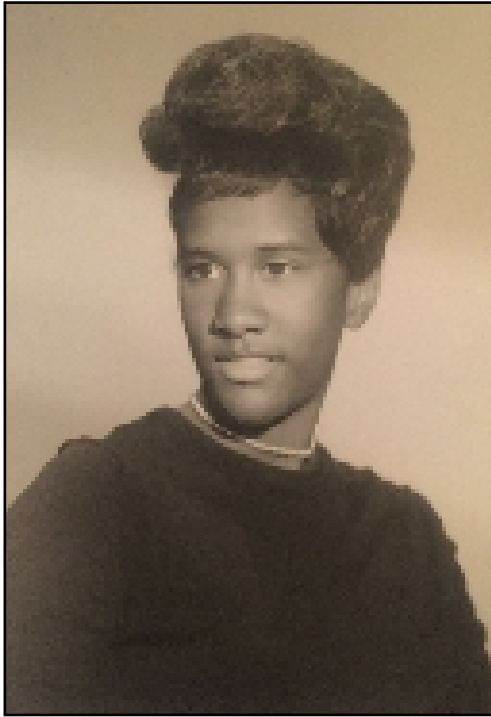

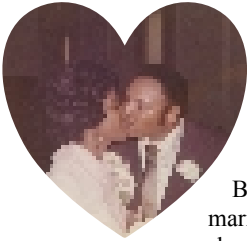

Reflections of Life



Mattie L. Adams was born September 7, 1946 in Manhattan, Kansas to the late Earl and Mattie Lallis. She graduated from New Brunswick High School. After graduation she worked for RCA then later was employed for thirty-one years at Verizon Communications in Madison, NJ until she retired in 2004.
