<u>Reflections of Life</u>

Mr. Ivan Johnson Sr. was born on June 20th 1928 at #28 Village West Coast Berbice, to the late Simeon and Florence Johnson. He was the first of twelve children.

In 1946, young Ivan journeyed to the Rupununi in search of employment to support his parents and younger siblings. In his early years, among them to earn a Government scholarship to attend the Government Technical Institute in Georgetown. Upon completion of his scholarship, Ivan assumed the position of Manager of the Lethem Power Str employment, he secured a job as the "Runner Boy" for the Governor of Lethem. This job allowed him, a position he held for many years until his retirement in 1989.

During his very adventurous years, Ivan met his first wife Hilda Sears in Annai. Their marriage produced six loving children before dissolving. Ivan then met his second wife Gloria Chan in Georgetown and this matrimony produced four more loving children.

In the 1960s, with his partner, Retired Corporal of the Guyana Police Force, Arthur Bobb, the two friends will become business partners and join forces to develop and manage a small business commonly referred to then as "Bobb Shop". In 1973 the partners ventured further into the business world, specifically into the Hotel industry and was able to give rise to another small family business they named "Takutu Guest House". Following his retirement, Ivan focused his time and efforts on the welfare of his family and building his businesses.

On December 10th, 2017, Ivan took his place in the arms of his Lord and Savior, at the Roraima General Hospital, Boa Vista, Brazil.

To cherish his precious memories, and preserve his legacy, Ivan leaves his wife Gloria Johnson, nine children: Edna Rodney, Desiree Hamilton, Joyce Sears, Loretta Johnson, Glen Johnson, Albert Johnson, Morsha Johnson-Francis, Ivan Johnson Jr, and Marlon Johnson. Two sisters; Margaret Nestor and Hulda Johnson and brother Winston Johnson; many nieces, nephews, grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Ivan Johnson Senior, the patriarch of the Johnson's family touched the lives of many in so many ways. He was loved dearly and respected tremendously by his family and friends.
