Dazzmen Lamond Johnson A.K.A “Candyman” was born on January 4, 1995 in Elizabeth, New Jersey, son of Clifford Hurling and Diana Johnson. Dazzmen lived in Linden most of his life and was a graduate of Linden High School in 2014.

Dazzmen continued his education at Monroe College in New Rochelle, New York where he majored in Criminal Justice. He was an outstanding Rugby player. He became the “inaugural captain” and “quickly established himself as an energetic leader.” “He was named team captain and later, its first “Most Valuable Player”. Dazzmen was an exceptional, determined young man with a bright future ahead of him.

He was an avid sportsman and standout athlete who played basketball, ran track & field and started a 3- year varsity quarterback for Linden High School. His career statistics were 2,685 passing yards, 22 passing touchdowns, 596 rushing yards, and 5 rushing touchdowns. During his youth, he played football for Roselle Pop Warner in Roselle. His favorite football team was the Philadelphia Eagles.

Dazzmen was a caring, loving and upstanding young man who loved life to the fullest. Dazzmen was family oriented and very close to his siblings. He was known as the “Big Brother.”

He met the love of his life, Chelsy Espinal while in college and they was blessed with one daughter, Maylani Avery.

On Friday, January 5, 2018, Dazzmen Lamond Johnson passed away from a brief illness at New York Presbyterian Hospital in New York at the age of twenty-three.

Dazzmen was predeceased by his grandparents: Clarence Hurling, Sr. and Lillie Mae Hurling; and Roosevelt Mitchell.
