

Obituary

Melvin Simmons was born on July 5, 1947 in Allendale County, South Carolina to the late Wilmer Washington, Sr. and Sarah Simmons. He departed this life on January 3, 2018 at the age of seventy.

Melvin did not have much formal education. He was self-taught, learning a trade in carpentry and woodwork that prepared him to make a living doing what he loved. His work rivaled that of carpenters who had excessive amounts of training that didn't prepare them with half the knowledge *Melvin* had.

He became a Master Cabinet Maker, working in the field over forty-five years. He owned his own business, Colormate Formica Works, as well as lending his expertise to other companies.

Melvin's favorite beverage was coffee, and everyone knew it. He also loved music. Jackie Wilson and Sam Cooke were among his favorite singers. Classical music was also on top of his list. When working, he often listened to Mozart, Beethoven, Bach, Chopin, Tchaikovsky, Handel and Vivaldi... to name a few.

Melvin was preceded in death by his mother and father; two sisters, Evelyn Alls and Richardean Simmons; and three brothers, John C. Simmons, Harry J. Simmons, Sr. and Wilmer Washington, Jr.
