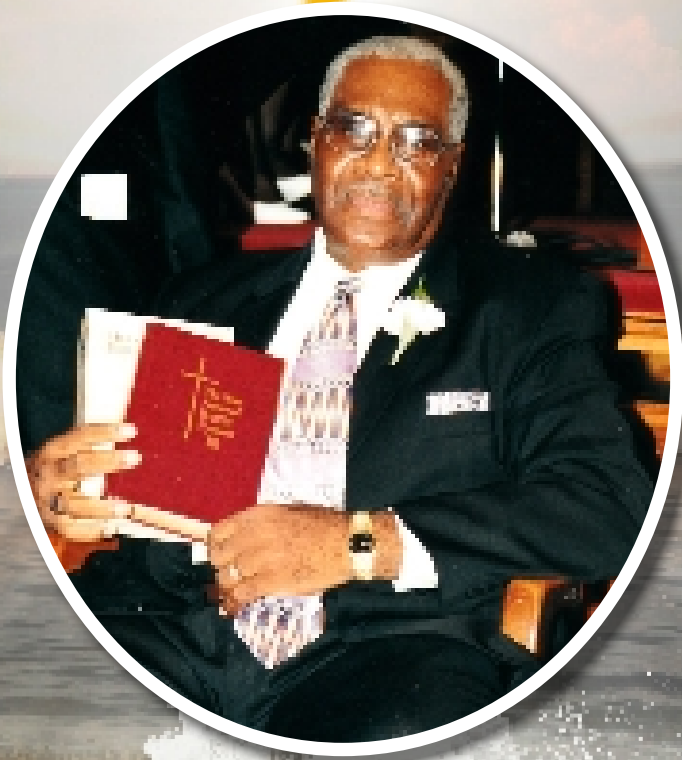

Obituary

Freddie Hubbard was born on June 26, 1936 to the late Mitchell Hubbard and Vera M. Brown-Hubbard in Blakely, GA. He departed this life on Wednesday, February 7, 2018 at his home in Newark, NJ. He was the third child out of 6 children.

Freddie graduated from Blakely High School in Georgia. He later moved to Newark, NJ in 1960. His first job was manager at Raleigh's Car Wash in Newark, NJ. He also worked for Celotex Chemical Company for many years in Edge Water, NJ and for the Livingston New Jersey School System as a custodian for several years before he retired. Freddie was a hard worker.
