Alzata married the late Arthur Garrett in 1944, from this union, four children were born. Then, Alzata wed the late Bill Donaldson, from this union, one child was born. Later, Alzata wed the late Edward Smith, from this union, the last child was born.

Later in life, Alzata moved to Newark, NJ. She continued her involvement in the community with New Hope Baptist Church and with her career in the dry cleaning. During this time, Alzata obtained her High School degree.

Alzata leaves to cherish her memory, her sister Lottie M. Wright Cliffwood, NJ; her six children, Arthur Garrett Jr. (Laverne) Hillside, NJ; Elaine Spencer (Mathew) Irvington, NJ; Joyce Smith Baltimore, MD; Danny Garrett (Joycie) Newark, NJ; Julia Donaldson Baltimore, MD; Edward Smith (Michelle) Hillside, NJ. This old world I'll see no more


Pain and suffering for me Is out the door
