She received her education through the Newark Public School system; she graduated from Malcolm X Shabazz High School in 1975, and went on to attend Essex County College.

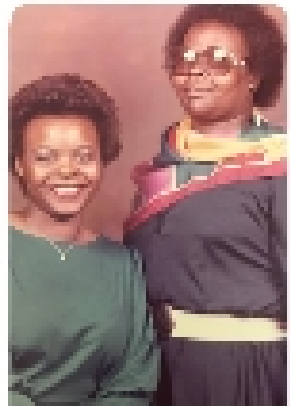
