E. Clara (Thomas) Holloway was called home from labor to reward on Sunday, March 11, 2018 following a brief illness. She was born January 25, 1921 in Camden, South Carolina. She was the third child of the late Zack and Barbara Thomas. Sister Holloway was educated in the Ridgewood New Jersey School System.

Sister Holloway was employed by the Curtiss Wright Aeronautical Corp. for 35 years. While working and raising her family she pursued her bachelor degree one course at a time, beginning at Tombrock College West Paterson and completed her degree at William Paterson College in 1981. She was later employed by the Paterson Board of Education as an Elementary School Teacher.

She loved to travel extensively around the globe, and went to many parts of the Caribbean and Europe with her beloved husband and children. She would play pinochle claiming she couldn't remember how to play while beating her opponents unmercifully. She was truly a social butterfly entertaining family and friends with plenty of food and good times.

She was a member of Calvary Baptist Church Paterson for more than 67 years. During her time at Calvary, she was President of the Women's Fellowship, a member of the Gospel Chorus and Chancel Choir. As a member of the Progressive Women she was one of the committee members responsible for bringing Dr. Mary McLeod Bethune to Calvary Baptist Church.

Sister Holloway was very civic minded, she lent her time and talent to several organizations which included being a member of the Bergen/Passaic Chapter of Jack and Jill of America; a life member of the Paterson Branch of the NAACP; Life member of Passaic County Section of National Council of Negro Women; Charter member of the Bergen/Passaic 100 Black Women Coalition; and a member of Paterson Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority.

Sister Holloway met her husbandman Arthur W. Holloway and was married on August 5, 1950 and from this union they were blessed with two daughters, Cynthia Holloway and Valerie Reels.

She is predeceased by her parents, Zack and Barbara Thomas, seven brothers Ernest (Billie) Alexander, Welton (WT) Thomas, Zack Thomas, Leonard Thomas, Miles (Mike) Thomas, Albert Thomas and Tyrone Thomas; 2 sisters Viola Thomas and Eva (Barbara) Pate.

She is survived by her beloved husband of sixty-seven years Arthur W. Holloway, three brothers Nathan (Edward) Thomas of Paramus, NJ, Harold Thomas and James Thomas of Paterson, NJ.
