Obituary

After a hard-fought battle with pancreatic cancer **Belinda Khalilah Dix** passed away on July 14, 2018 in Upstate Hospital, Syracuse NY at the age of 61. She leaves behind a son Rabbi-El Dix.

Belinda was born December 1, 1956 in Newark, NJ to Lucretia and Benjamin Dix, who predeceased her. She grew up in a large, loving family with 3 sisters. Belinda attended Bragaw Ave Elementary School and Weequahic High school, graduating in 1974. She attended Fairleigh Dickinson University in Rutherford, NJ for three years and went on to work in the clerical field.

In 2001, Belinda moved to Syracuse, NY, where she worked in sales. Belinda was an avid reader, loved music, dancing and was heavily involved in the church. Belinda taught Sunday School and worked with teens at Victory Temple Fellowship Church in Syracuse, NY. Belinda loved children and giving back to her community. When diagnosed with pancreatic cancer in January 2017, Belinda remained dedicated to the church and optimistic that she would beat cancer. Belinda remained brave, even throughout her final weeks.

Belinda is survived by her son Rabbi-El and sisters Jeannine Dix-Clark and Sherri Dix-Glover, Quadri Dix, Charles Amir Glover, Poche Hill and numerous other nieces and nephews. She is preceded in death by her parents and sister Evonne. Belinda lived and was loved.

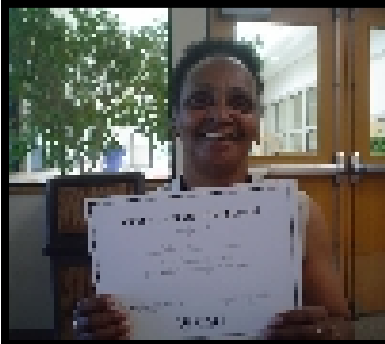
