

Shawn-Paul enjoyed being social and engaging with others. It has been said that he was the best dressed young man in school. He loved attention and was quite the flirt. His favorite things to do were swimming, going camping at Visions Center for the blindness where he was loved by Bill, Cathy, Dawn, Travis, Teddy, Carmen, Crystal, Khaled, and the rest of our VCB family and friends. He also enjoys squeaky toys, music and his favorite color was green.

Shawn-Paul and his parents joined Cathedral United Baptist Church in 2008. Shawn-Paul began his education at UCP where he attended pre-k and continued his education at P10x from kindergarten through 5th grade. This past summer was spent at P723. But most recently a new world was being opened for him at his new school iBrain (International Institute for the brain) which specializes in traumatic brain injury and brain disorders where they were able to take the time to unlock his full potential. There is where he was introduced to a team of people who allowed him to prosper.
