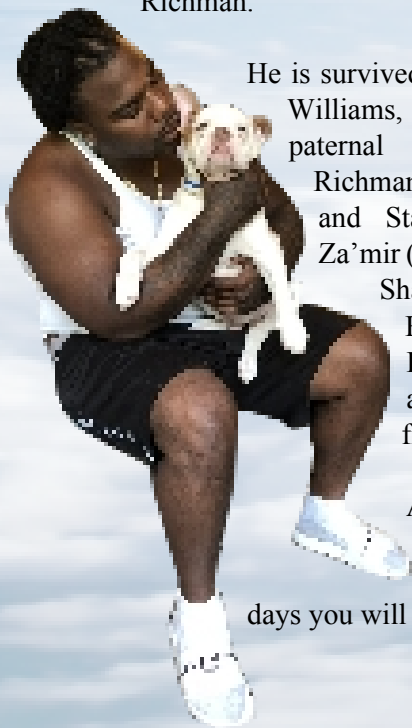

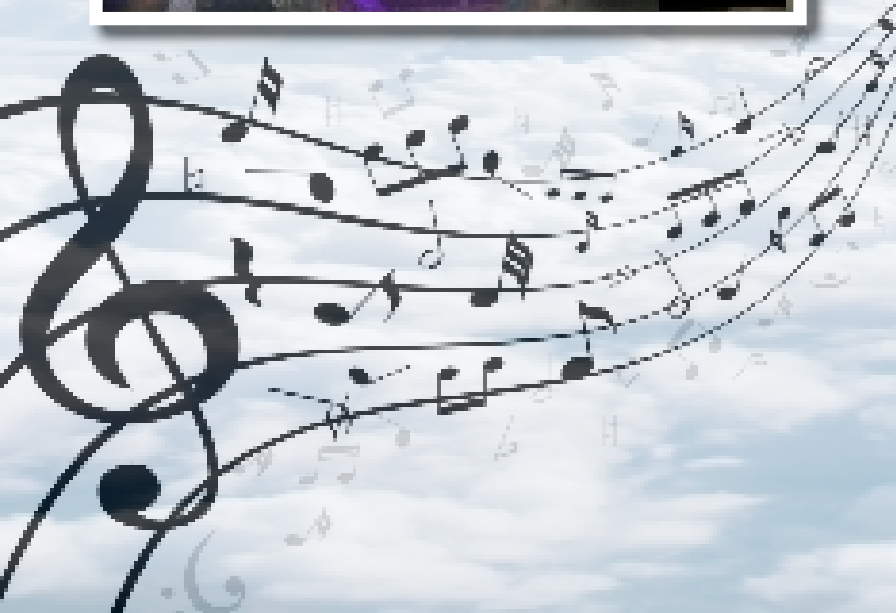
Akean will be remembered for making his presence known a mile away, his love/hate charm, being family and friend oriented as well as his love for music, his style of fashion and expertise in money.
