

# <u>Obituary</u>

**Dr. Joseph Onyekwelu Onubogu, PhD** was born in March of 1960, the fifth child of Chief John Chukwuma Onubogu and Celina Ekema Okafor. Though born in Bauchi State, Dr. Joseph Onubogu and his family relocated to the parents' hometown, Nkwelle-Ezunaka, when he was just 3. All throughout his primary and secondary school education, his teachers observed his innate tenacity, dedication, and academic excellency, all of which are traits he displayed throughout his life.

Growing up, Dr. Joseph Onubogu enjoyed many different pursuits. As an avid writer and thinker, he participated in both a writer's society and a debate club where he was able to cultivate both of those interests. Born with a natural charisma,. Dr. Joseph Onubogu's academic pursuits afforded him the ability to meet people both like and unlike him.

Dr. Joseph Onubogu was one of the few selected by the Nigerian government to be awarded a chance to study abroad through federal funding. Though admitted into a medical program at the University of Nigeria in Nsukka, he knew that the financial burden was not something he wanted to leave with his parents. Due to his kind heart and curiosity, he chose to study abroad instead.

From there, Dr. Onubogu collected a series of degrees: a Masters in Electrical Engineering, a Masters in Computer Science, a Masters in Philosophy, and a Doctorate in Educational Psychology. His passion for learning was evident not only in the degrees he obtained, but the lasting relationships he formed with college faculty and peers.

Throughout his entire career, Dr. Joseph Onubogu worked as a teacher throughout the New York and New Jersey Public School system. Dr. Joseph Onubogu has taught students in New York Public Schools (in AP maths and sciences), Rutgers University, City College University of New York, and New Jersey City University. Dr. Onubogu was passionate in teaching and empowering his students, creating curriculum that would fit the classroom and encouraging students to be self-motivated. Dr. Onubogu strongly believed that knowledge is power and that the greatest leaders know that there is always more to learn. To his students, to his peers, and to his family, Dr. Joseph Onubogu was a teacher of unimaginable knowledge and life experience. And so, even in death, we learn from him.

Dr. Joseph Onubogu is survived by his wife, Chizoba, and his five children, Joseph Jr., Ivana, William, Andrew, and Michael.


We are all going the same In the same place Knowing that we are loved by God In him we trust and hope

Yearning for that we had Cringing on what he had Fighting to hold on tight Seeking to have another minute


I wonder if you have a chance To live life all again and again Would you have a second thought To make it right and embrace life
