Patricia Ann Jackson's Life Journey

Patricia Ann Jackson was born March 8, 1953, to Mr. Eddie (deceased) and Mrs. Delonia Hagen in Screven County, Georgia. She departed this life on November 21, 2018 after battles with cancer for over 20 years. She was preceded in death by her husband, Reginald Jackson Sr.

Trish or Trish Ann, as her family and special friends so fondly called her, joined the St. John Baptist Church of Oliver, GA at an early age. She attended Sunday School and became a member of the church's choir at a young age. She was educated in the Scriven County School System graduating in 1971. She was married to Jerome Hicks from 1971-1977. Three children were born from this union; daughter; LaZabre; and two sons, Nakia and Douglas. She worked at White Stagg Clothing Manufacturer for 3 years.

Pat made a life changing decision when she moved to the Washington Metropolitan area in 1977 were she began working at the Robert E. Moore Real Estate Company and to further her education, she completed the Washington School for secretaries nightly graduating in 1978.

In 1988, Pat married the love of her life Reginald Jackson Sr. From this marriage, they became a blended family with 10 children. They shared a marriage of 18 years until his passing in 2005.

She was employed by Ginns Office Supply Retail division where she worked as an administrative assistant for the vice-president of retail sales. From there to Zytron Corporation, a microfiche corporation where she began as a receptionist and ended up a top sales person. The company was purchased and the sales department was dissolved. From there she worked for Boy Scouts of America as a registration clerk. Continuing to move forward in employment she worked for the city of Glenarden as the town clerk. During this time, she began working for First Baptist Church of Glenarden in the evening.

January 1990, she began full-time employment as secretary to Pastor John K. Jenkins, Sr. of First Baptist Church of Glenarden (FBCG). She was responsible for the cornerstone laying and ribbon cutting ceremonies for the move from 3311 Brightseat Road to 3600 Brightseat Road now the Ministry Center. This was a transition period for FBCG after the passing of the late Pastor John W. Johnson. Deacon Leon Houston (deacons chairperson at that time) appointed Pat as the 1989 FBCG Women's Day Chairperson. During her tender as chairperson she introduced church recognition with t-shirts and sweat-shirts for both men and women. She started honoring those in ministry by presentation of plaques for their service.

After 13 years of faithful service to Pastor Jenkins Sr., there was a reorganization within FBCG Administration. Pat was transferred to the position of administrative assistant to the employed ministerial staff. In addition to her new position, she was also the liaison representative from FBCG with couples preparing for marriage.

Her duties also included conference travel for various ministries as well as the ministerial staff. In 2016, she was reassigned as the administrative assistant to FBCG Spiritual Cares Ministry, Marketing & PR, and Project Bridges. Pat completed 25 years of service with the First Baptist Church of Glenarden in 2016.

In 1984, Pat joined First Baptist Church of Glenarden. She was a member of the Early Morning Gospel Chorus, Dorcas, and Evangelism Ministries. She furthered her spiritual growth and knowledge by completing several Bible Institute classes.

In 2006, Pat listened to the direction of the Holy Spirit by moving her membership to one of FBCG Church plants, Calvert County Baptist Church, under the pastoral leadership of Pastor Darryl Godlock.

One of Pat's greatest accomplishments in life (her bucket list), was graduating with her Bachelor's Degree from Strayer University in 2016.
