Leslie Constantine French was born in Queens, New York on January 24, 1961. The Lord took him home on November 21, 2018 at Kingsbrook Jewish Medical Center in Brooklyn, New York.

Growing up, Leslie attended the Linden-Jamaica Seventh Day Adventist Elementary School and then graduated from the Northeastern Academy in the Bronx, New York. After a brief time in college, he began working as a parking attendant at the Kinney Parking Systems. Several years later, Leslie joined Services for the Under Served to reorganize his life.

After joining Services for the Under Served, Leslie held various positions of employment. He worked as a facility maintenance worker, a security guard, and later after successfully completing the required courses, he became a Peer Specialist. He particularly enjoyed the Peer Specialist position because it involved helping individuals prepare for job interviews, and getting their lives back on track.

For recreation Leslie enjoyed playing chess. He became so adept at the game that he won 1st place in the chess club tournament in 1998. A few years later, he began spending a major portion of his time studying the Bible, and fellowshipping with family members.

In 2008, Leslie joined the S.D.A. Community Tabernacle of Praise church. There he would attend Bible Study during the week and Divine Service on Saturdays. Leslie was an honest and open person, and he would often give testimonies about his struggles and aspirations.

Leslie was known as a very generous and loving person. He was particularly fond of his nieces and nephews. He was always excited when any one of them were in his company. Leslie made sure to visit his nieces and nephews in Texas and Georgia whenever he could.

Leslie leaves unique and fond memories to his brother Desi (Maxine), his brother Cornelius (Roslyn), his sister Adrienne, his brother Reginald, his dear mother Mary, his nephews: Justin, Jonathan, Christopher, Xavier, Cornelius III, Wynton, Elijah, Caleb and his nieces: Kenisha, Ashley, Denee, Francine, Joy, and Hope.
