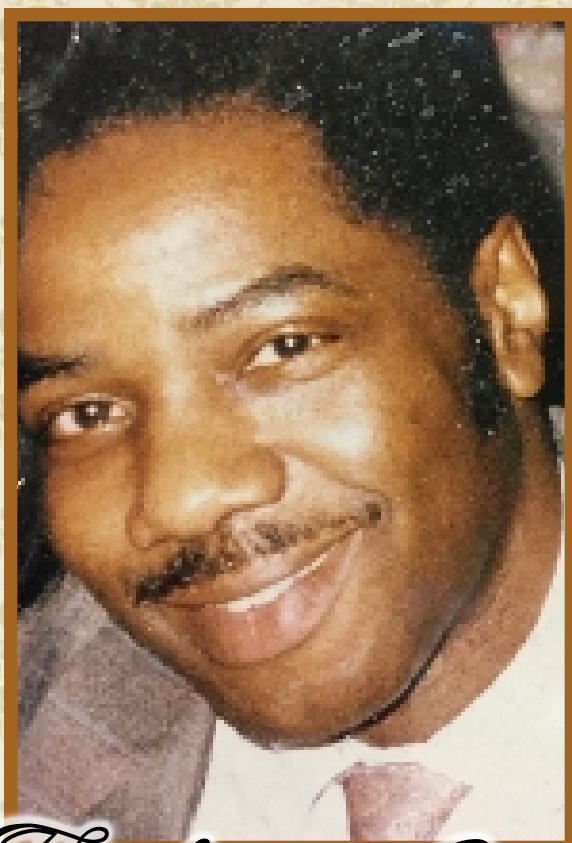

Obituary

Nathan Grant, was the third child born to Mabel and Leo Grant on May 18, 1947 in Harlem, New York. Born and raised in Harlem, Nathan graduated from George Washington High School in Washington Heights.

Shortly after at the young age of 19, Nathan began his service in the Army where he fought for his country in the Vietnam War. After returning to New York, Nathan continued his studies in the evenings at Hunter College while working during the day at Chase Bank.
