<u>Obituary</u>

Deacon Eugene Raymond Long, \$r. was born to Joseph Long and Florrie Price Long on October 9, 1937 in Jersey City, New Jersey. He was the youngest of seven siblings. He was educated in the Jersey City School System and graduated from Ferris High School in 1957. While at Ferris High School, Gene and his brother Joseph Long were champion gymnasts. After high school, he enlisted in the U.S. Air Force and served four and a half years before being honorably discharged in 1961.

In 1964, he married Gwendolyn Dudley and they have one son, Eugene R. Long, Jr. Deacon Long participated in the commissioning of his son as a lieutenant upon his graduation from the Virginia Military Institute in 1994.

Gene studied electronics and graduated from RCA Institute of Technology in 1971. He was employed by NYNEX, which became Verizon, as a communications analyst until he retired in 1999. The family relocated from Jersey City to South Orange in 1976 and joined First Baptist Church in 1984. Gene was ordained as a deacon in 1989 and went on to serve as a Chaplain at University Hospital in Newark.
