Minister Cynthia was educated in the Paterson Public School system where she graduated in 1971 from Eastside High School. After high school she attended Lincoln University where she received her BA degree in Social Studies. Min. Cynthia was a true history buff and an avid reader. Reading 5 books per week would not be excessive for her, it was truly enjoyable. Min. Cynthia loved to do jigsaw puzzles and complete word games in her spare time. Two of her favorite TV shows were, "God Friended Me" and "Double Jeopardy". Earlier in life, Cynthia and her parents were on bowling leagues and she was able to hold her own.

After college, Min. Cynthia worked as a teacher at Paterson Public School #28 for approximately 5 years. Even today, many of the students remember her and commented on how serious she was about teaching. Min. Cynthia changed her career path to the United State Postal Service where she was initially a window clerk in the Paterson branch office and after 25 years she ended her career in
