Obituary

Bishop Cleave Cutliff peacefully passed away Monday, January 21, 2019 at Methodist Hospital in Brooklyn, NY.

Bishop Cleave Cutliff was born on August 2, 1951 to Mrs. Katie Jackson McNealy and he was the oldest of ten children.

He received his education in the Mt Dora School system in Florida and graduated from Mt. Dora High School and moved to NJ in 1970.

In 1974, he joined the St Luke Church Of Christ Disciples Of Christ in East Orange, NJ under the leadership of the late Elder John Stevens. He served on the Trustee & Deacon board and sang in the Celestial Choir. Bishop Cutliff was called to the ministry and ordained under the United Fellowship Assembly in 1984. He was the pastor of the Friendly Church of Christ, Disciples Of Christ for fifteen years in Plainfield, NJ.

He obtained the following degrees: Bachelor's degree in Bible Studies Masters of Religious Arts in Theology Doctor of Divinity Doctorate in Ministries. He also was an instructor at the United Fellowship Assembly Bible Institute in Jamaica, NY where the late Bishop Roosevelt Hinnant was the founder. An active member of the United Fellowship Assembly where he served as a union President for over ten years and as chairman of the council board for six years.

During this time, he met and married Angela Hinnant. He was elected Pastor of the Macedonia Church Of Christ, Disciples Of Christ March 2005 and October 2010 Bishop Cutliff was elected vice Bishop of United Fellowship Assembly Church Of Christ Disciples of Christ.

He worked for Midtown Meat Packing Company in Newark NJ, Orange Memorial Hospital in Orange, NJ and retired from NJ Transit as a bus driver for 30 yrs. Bishop Cutliff had love for family church and friends.

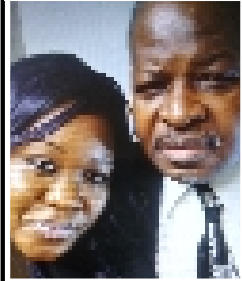
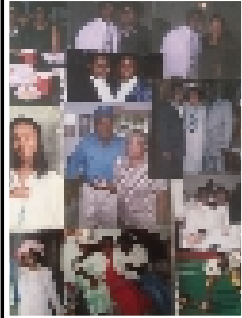
