

Obituary

Dane Gifford Johnson, son of Eugennie Williams and the late Alanzo Johnson, was born on February 26, 1979 in Savannala-mar, Westmoreland, Jamaica.

As a youth, he attended Grange Hill Primary School, then went on to the best high school in Western Jamaica -Manning's School, where he was a member of the school's track team and a star player on the football (soccer) team. Upon graduation, "Little Fussy", as he was lovingly called by so many, migrated to the United States of America where he was awarded a soccer scholarship to Herkimer College. After graduating from Herkimer College with his Associate Degree, he once again accepted a soccer scholarship, this time to the University of South Carolina. However, he was unhappy with the general atmosphere there, and in true "Little Fussy's" personality — he would never stay in a situation that he didn't like — he transferred a semester later to his final college home, Oneonta College (SUNY). In 2005, he graduated with his Bachelor of Arts degree in Business with a minor in Computer Science.

Dane moved back to New York City upon completion of his studies. For six years, he worked as a Department Manager at Century 21 Department Store; however, self-employment became a dream of his and he resigned from that position to open his own business, Downstate Surgical & Medical Supply, Inc., of which he was the sole proprietor. In May 2010, Dane married his childhood friend Keisha, and their union produced one child, Jevaro. Dane was also the loving father of his older children, Makayla and Destin.

Dane had an intense love for family and that was reflected in the care of, and time spent with Makayla, Destin, and Jevaro. His other interests included hanging out with his friends; playing soccer; watching football, track and field, and basketball, and traveling. All who knew him will remember him as an avid New England Patriots fan.
