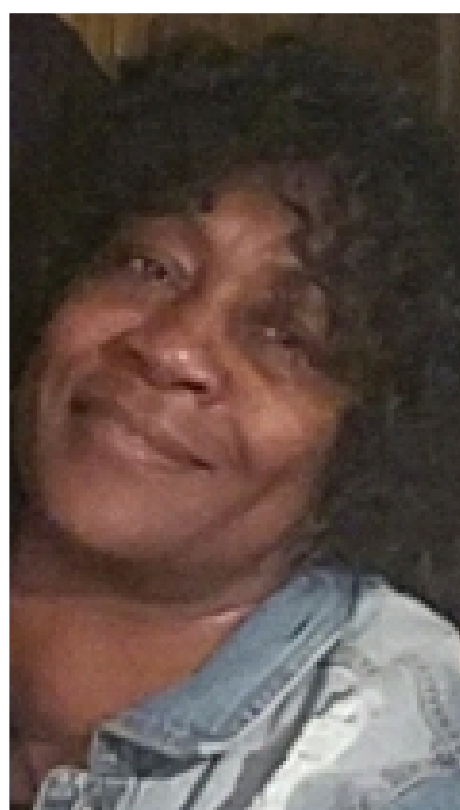

Laveda was the 8th child of 10 born on December 13, 1952 to the late Isiah and Dorothy Rudolph. She made her eternal transition on March 25, 2019.

Laveda confessed Christ at an early age, she joined Friendship Baptist Church Georgiana, AL.

Laveda attended R L Austin School an all black school in Georgiana, AL from 1967 to 1969 where she was a drum major for the high school marching band upon desegregation. She graduated from Georgiana High School, where she was the first black cheerleader. She then attended Trenholm Technical College of Montgomery, Alabama where she studied cosmetology.

Laveda relocated to Bayonne, New Jersey in 1982. She was employed with the Bayonne Board of Education. Laveda became a member of New Zion Baptist Church of Bayonne, New Jersey. Later she became a member of Central Baptist Church also of Bayonne, New Jersey under the leadership of Pastor Dingle. She loved the Lord; and was a faithful and dedicated member of the church. She was part of the Pastor's Aid committee and the Celestial Choir. The last song that she sung was "I'm to close to the mirror to see what you see in me." She is now singing in the heavenly choir.

She always "Happily" cooked collard greens and cornbread for the pastor's anniversary. Her favorite saying at church was "I love my pastor and my first lady."

Laveda was preceded in death by her parents Dorothy and Isiah Rudolph. Her daughter Kimberly Rudolph Branch, Brother Willie Dell Rudolph and Nephew Tory Rudolph.
