Reflections of Life

Harriet Elizabeth (Mann) Bradley, 97, returned to her heavenly home on April 4, 2019, after a valiant battle with a long term heart illness. Her unwavering belief in God and the loving support of her family ultimately gave her all the joy and peace she would ever need.

Harriet was born to the late Augustus and Mary Mann, a Methodist preacher and a homemaker respectively, in Savannah, Georgia on June 12, 1921. She was a fighter from the very beginning as doctors concluded she wouldn't live beyond infancy. In preparation of her passing Harriet's father made her a coffin out of shoe box. However, she defied the odds then and continued to do so throughout her life. Harriet grew and developed into a beautiful stylish young woman.

She relocated to New York in the 1940's and pursued a career as a seamstress. One day her friend and co-worker introduced Harriet to her little brother. The two became inseparable and on July 18, 1948, in Bronx, NY, she married her best friend and soul mate, Harold Bradley. On January 25, 1969, they welcomed their daughter Sharlene Lavelle to the family.

Harriet had a broad professional career. In addition to working as a seamstress, she was once a steel mill worker and a home health aide. However, Harriet will be remembered best for her service to God through her local church.

As a member of Mount Bethel Baptist Church Ridgewood, Harriet was a choir singer, Missionary, bible study teacher and Deaconess. However, her service to God extended well beyond the church walls.

She prepared meals with her sister Louise Hamilton for street ministry, visited the sick and "shut-in" and taught a home bible study as well. Harriet's love affair with God and people came together in a compilation of songs she wrote that encouraged others to pursue a relationship with God. She truly was a champion of the Gospel and an instrument used by God.

She is preceded in death by her sisters; Edith Degazon, Augustus Paige, her brother, William Mann and her parents.

Harriet is survived by her husband, Harold Bradley; sister, Louise Hamilton, daughter, Sharlene Lavelle Palmer, son-in-law, Anthony Palmer, Sr.; Grandchildren, Olivia Palmer, and Anthony Palmer, Jr., as well as a host of nieces, nephews, great nieces, and great nephews.
