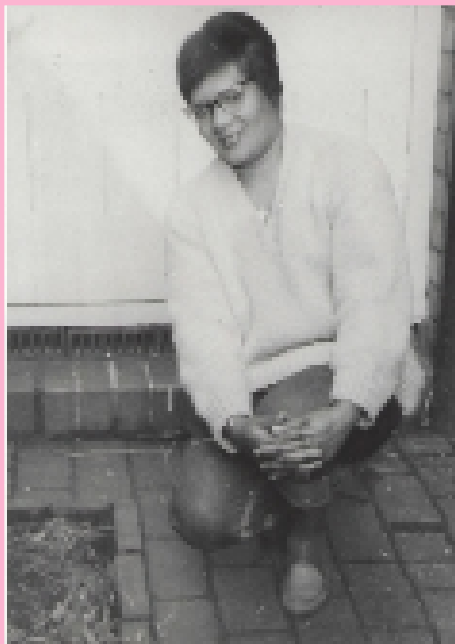
Obituary

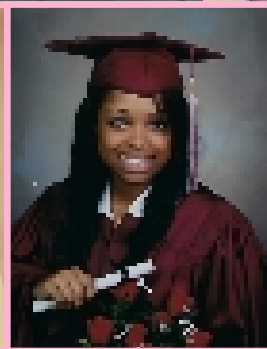
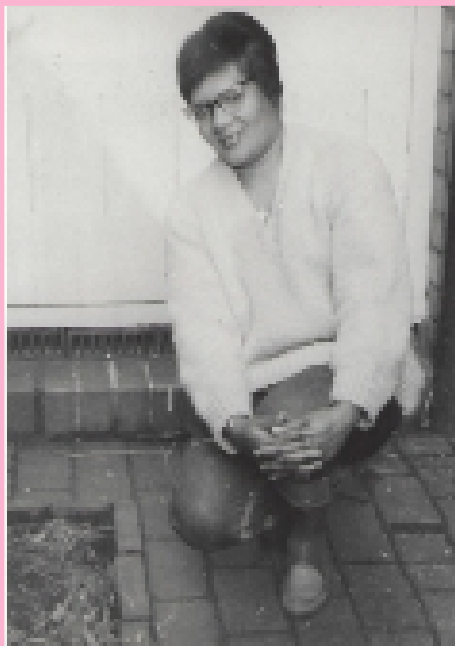
