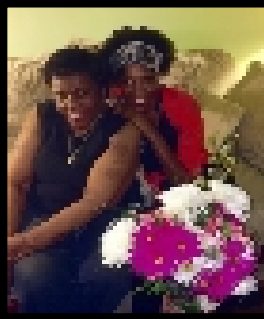
Community and Church Involvement

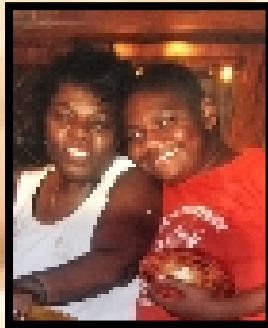
