She was a supportive, articulate, confident, and determined woman who embraced independence and achieved much in her life. Christine loved to drive her own car, and when coerced to stop driving, she figured out how to use the Access Link, there was no stopping Christine!

Christine transitioned from her earthly home to her heavenly home on Friday, June 7, 2019, at Complete Care at Hamilton Plaza located in Passaic, New Jersey surrounded by her family.
