She attended the Newark Public School system and graduated from The Girls Vocational High School class of 1966.

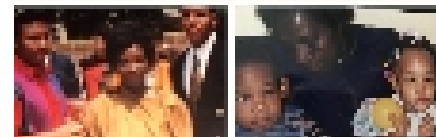
