Edna Pauline Gaither was born on October 21, 1930, in Baltimore, Maryland. Edna, affectionately known as Beebe, was educated in the Baltimore Public School system. She was an outstanding student who excelled in academics and participated in cheerleading, music, dance and field sports. Upon high school graduation at age 16, she began her course of study at Morgan State College. Shortly thereafter, she moved to New York City with her mother, Thomasina and stepfather, Robert Allen, who served our nation as a Chief Petty Officer in the United States Navy. Beebe worked several jobs in the city before meeting Robert Rose Keene. They fell in love, married and relocated to Newark, NJ and settled into married life. Their 16-year union brought forth four children: Anna Rose, Russell Alan, Jacquelyn Yvonne and Julian Alexander.

In 1967, Beebe married her long-time friend and bridge partner, Pierce Hampton, also known as Hamp, with whom she remained until his death in 2006. Together they reared four children in a home filled with love, good food, books and music, and by example, taught them the meaning of family and the value of education, hard work and responsible living. During the early '70's, Beebe enrolled at Kean University and graduated with a Bachelor's degree in Economics. She was respected as a woman of grace and integrity and widely regarded as a fierce competitor and consummate professional. From an entry level job in the US Postal Service, Beebe ascended to the position of Northeast Regional Director of Procurement Services—the position she held until retirement in 1989.

During their 39 years together, Beebe and her beloved Hamp—both life master bridge players—indulged their passion for world travel, Scrabble, Pac-Man, crosswords, games of strategy, cards, pets, and most of all, time with their precious grandchildren. She was an excellent cook and planner whose creative touches made our holidays, milestones, family celebrations and Sunday dinners unforgettable. Her zest for life was boundless, and she approached all situations with audacity and certainty of purpose. Beebe was a devoted wife and mother whose courage, determination, sacrifice and offbeat humor made our home a special place. She will forever be our source of strength, inspiration and love.

Edna transitioned on Tuesday, June 25, 2019. Left to mourn her passing and honor her traditions are her children: Anna, Russell, Jacquelyn and Julian; son-in-law, Gerald; daughters-in-law: Yvonne, Barbara and Mary; grandchildren: Fard, Ya-Sin, Dorian, Kelley, Julian, Jr., Crystal and husband, Dwayne; her loving companion and great-granddaughter, Alycia; and a host of in-laws, relatives and friends.
