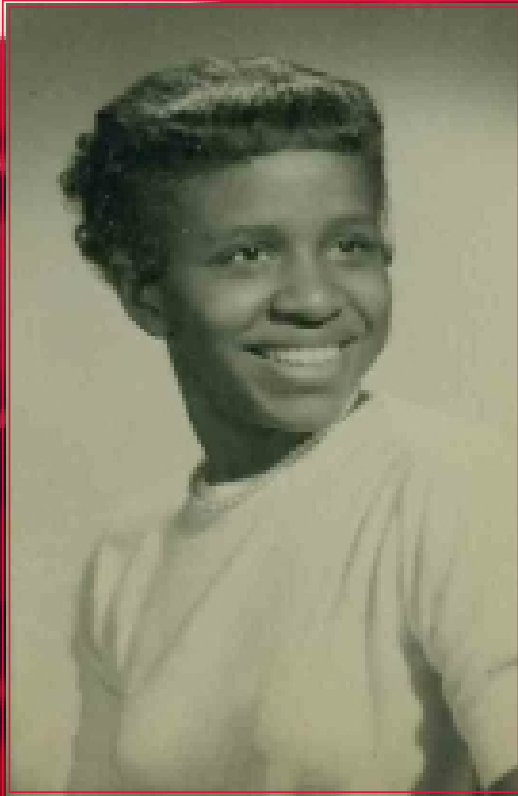

Obituary

Barbara Anne Huguenin was born on September 17, 1939 in Newark, New Jersey. She was the second of four children born to the late Madie Irby (Flowers) and Henry Irby.

Barbara attended the East Orange Public School System and graduated from East Orange High School in 1957. She then attended Hampton Institute in Hampton, Virginia. Barbara married Joseph Huguenin, Jr. in 1959 and to this union, two children were born: Jo Cheryl and Kevin. Barbara worked in management at NJ Bell (now Verizon) for over 30 years, making long lasting friendships along the way.

Barbara loved her dogs, including dobermans and miniature schnauzers. Her last dog, Kousette, a French briard, led to her next chapter - working for several years at the Millburn Veterinary Hospital with Dr. Glauberg.
