Jermaine continued his studies until he graduated from Frederick Douglass Academy III High School in the year 2014.

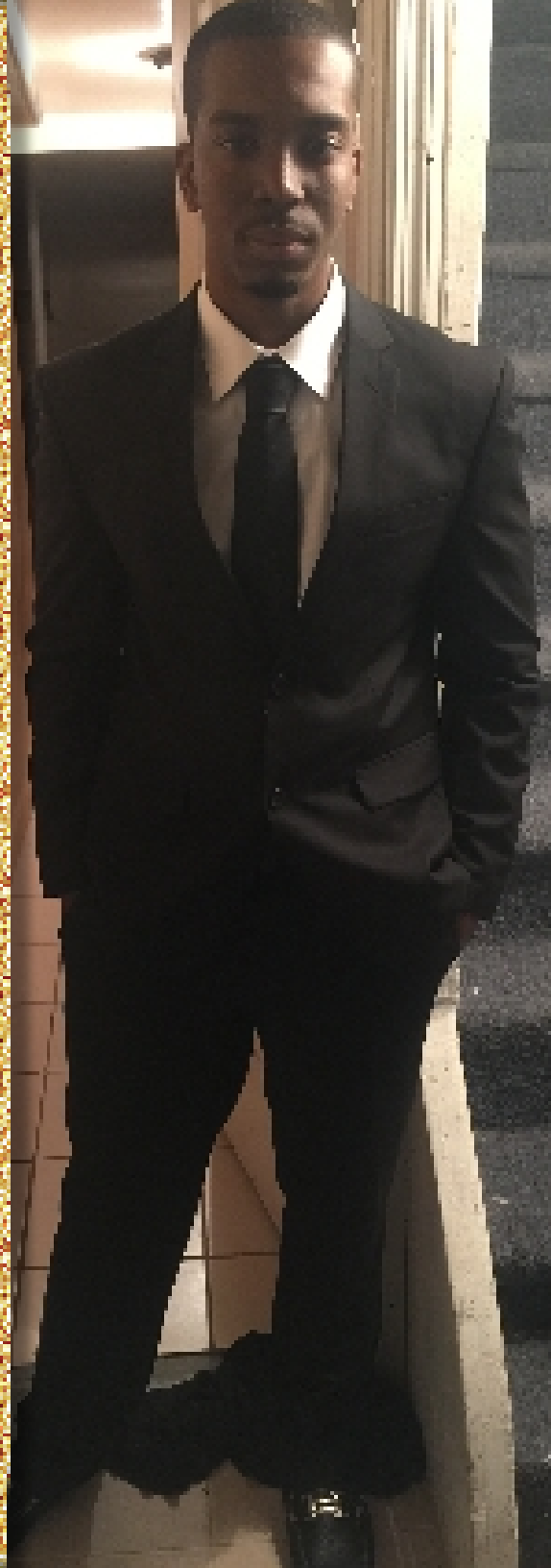

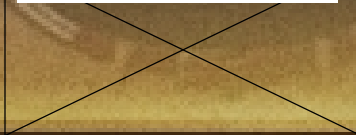
