Jewel Lee Daniels, affectionally known as "Jazzy J", was born on June 28, 1935, in Birmingham, AL, to the late Rev. Osborne C. and Geneva Carter, one of seven children. After a long illness, Jewel went on to take her rest peacefully on July 9, 2019.

Jewel graduated from Ullman High, in Birmingham, AL. She met and married the late Andrew Daniels. From this union, they had four children, Andrew, Linda, Deborah and Cynthia. In 1965, the family relocated to Newark, NJ. Once in NJ, Jewel continued her education, attending Rutgers University.

Jewel was a jazzy woman, full of life, with several passions in photography, sewing, fashion and cooking, to name a few. Her real passion and calling was helping others, which she spent majority of her life fulfilling. She was the director at Project WHO, an inner city after school program in Newark that helped teenagers prepare for their futures. During her busy life, Jewel found time to pursue her interest in cooking, selling BBQ ribs on the weekend, during the summer. Later, she pursued her passion for fashion by becoming an entrepreneur, opening Jewel's World of Fashion in East Orange, NJ. However, she could not escape her true calling for helping others and became the Director of Donald Tucker Community Center in Newark, NJ (The Centre Inc.) She was also one of the original coordinators of the Seniors and Youth groups of the Black Issues Convention.

At an early age, Jewel loved The Lord. She was a devoted and faithful member of New Hope Baptist Church, where she served on the Food/Clothing Ministry, and Prayer Line Ministry. On October 9, 2005, Jewel was ordained a Deaconess, an accomplishment she cherished.

Due to her illness, she could not physically attend service regularly, but her faith in God remained strong until she was called home to rest. She would say with true conviction, "Keep your hands in God's hand. He will see you through no matter what".

There's much more to be said of Jazzy J, this amazing phenomenal woman. We are going to truly miss her!
