Reflections of Life

Pastor JD Dickson was born on May 3, 1942 in Lake City, South Carolina. He was the son of the late Melvin and Agnes (Nero) Dickson. He was educated in the local schools in Lake City, SC.

On December 23, 1961, JD married the love of his life Lacishia (Epps). Shortly thereafter they relocated to Paterson, NJ. He was a long time employee of NJ Transit Authority where he was employed for 40 years until his retirement.

Pastor JD Dickson accepted Christ as his Lord and Saviour in his younger years. He became an ordained minister under the leadership of Pastor Sadie Miles of the House of Prophecy and Prayer of Connecticut. He also served as a Minister along with his son Bishop Glenn Dickson. He later became the Pastor of Reborn Deliverance Center of Paterson where he served from 2001 until his passing.

Pastor JD Dickson was preceded in death by his parents Melvin and Agnes Dickson, his sisters Sherby Hardy, Verndell Carmichael and his brothers Rev. Talbert Dickson and Rocky Dickson.

Pastor JD Dickson, 77, of Paterson preached his final sermon titled "*There is Another Man Coming*" on Sunday, August 18, 2019. He transitioned from this life and entered eternal rest shortly after at St. Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson.
