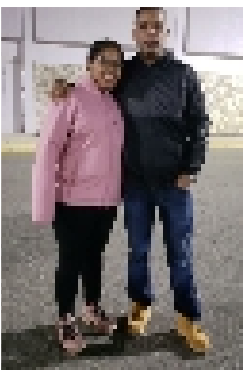
A Tribute to Daddy
