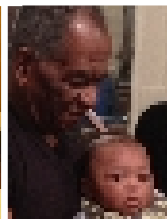
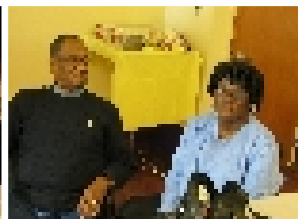
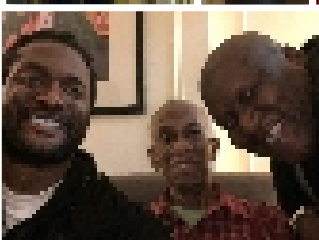
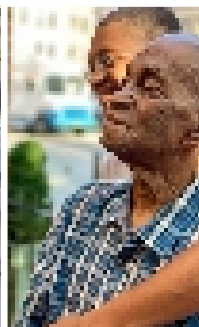
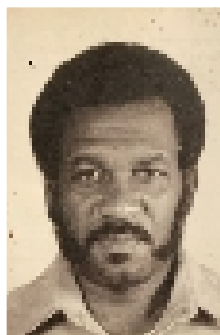
## *Reflections of Life*

***George Leroy Nicholls, Sr.*** was born on June 09, 1935 in Barbados, West Indies, the eldest of three children. As a young man, George played cricket and began his masonry training in Barbados. He emigrated to New York in the early 1960s, and married Dolores (Johnson) Nicholls, his wife of 54 years. George and Dolores had four children: George Nicholls Jr. (deceased), Helena Nicholls, Edward Nicholls, and Michael Nicholls, and four grandchildren: Michael Nicholls Jr., Levi Nicholls, Evelyn Nicholls and Amara Nicholls.
