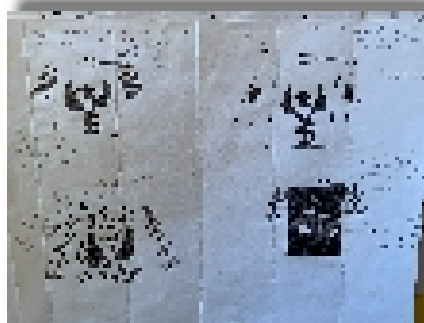
Tamel Dominique Dixon was born on December 28th 1993, at Lincoln Hospital to his beloved mother Charmaine Dixon.
