Obituary

John Willis Rountree II was the son of the late Deacon Moses Grover Rountree and the late Geruth Wilson Rountree. He was born February 10, 1942 in Newark, New Jersey. He departed this life Friday, November 22, 2019.

John was baptized at an early age at the Zion Hill Baptist Church in Newark, New Jersey and later he joined the Good Neighbor Baptist Church in 1971 and became a Trustee Board member.

John attended Charlton Street Elementary and Weequahic High Schools in Newark, New Jersey and completed 4 years at Michigan State University majored in Zoology with honors and later enrolled at Howard University Medical School not completed; Uncle Sam in May 17, 1966 inducted him, to clean toilets; departure May 16, 1968 and in the same year he married Ollie.

John in 1970 joined Good Neighbor Baptist Church work with the Founder's Council members and Pastor Dr. Malachi D. Rountree to build and established a Good Neighbor 501©3, Pre-School Programs, purchased Good Neighbor First Church Van, established (WJR) Wilson, Johnson and Rountree Investment Project, New Jersey Chartered Good Neighbor Pre-Legal Aide Project, Good Neighbor Companion Program, Good Neighbor Food Pantry, Good Neighbor Clothing Pantry Good Neighbor Love Gift Program, Good Neighbor Housing, Education Employment, Political Action and Homeless Task Forces and help to established the Good Neighbor Rahway Prison Escort Program.

John was a Lab Technician at the Veteran Hospital in East Orange where he met and married Mary Skipwith in 1982 and to this union one child was born, Autumn Rountree. He later became a Lab Technician at the Army Base Hospital, Wrihgtstown, New Jersey and the Hamilton Hospital, Hamilton, New Jersey. He later moved to Winter Park, Florida and in 1992 he relocated back to Newark, New Jersey.

John suffered with a stroke and was housed at Plaza Health Care & Rehabilitation Center in Elizabeth, New Jersey. His brother and sister-in-law took him in 2007 for better care.

He leaves to cherish his memory his daughter, Autumn Joy Rountree; two grandchildren, Austin and Johnathan Rountree, Moorestown, NJ, one brother, Rev. Dr. Malachi (Evelyn); West Orange, NJ; one sister-in-law, Louise Rountree, Newark, NJ, one nephew; Malachi (Karisa) Louisville, KY; nieces, Rev.
