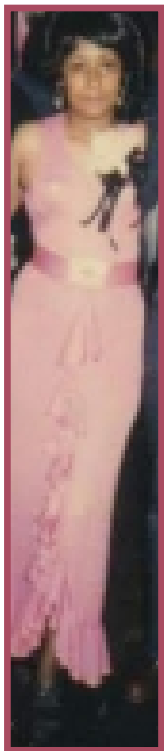

# *Grandma's Gone To Heaven*

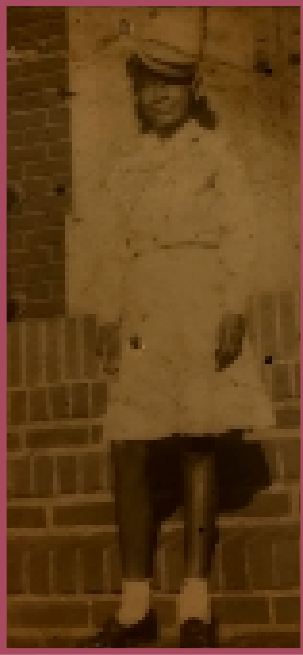
*One quiet day the angels came
