

# <u>Obituary</u>

Marvin Jackson was born the sixth child to the late Andrew and Cornelia Maddox Jackson on September 28, 1924 in Anderson County South Carolina. He departed this life on December 8, 2019. He was preceded in death by his son, James Eric (Ricky) Jackson, two brothers, William and Jay Jackson, three sisters, Azalee Mayes, Lanise Sullivan and Bernice Jackson.

Marvin and his family relocated to Greenville, South Carolina where he received his formal education. At an early age he accepted Christ as his personal Savior. In 1942, he joined the military serving in the United States Army, and was honorably discharged in 1945. Upon leaving the military, Marvin briefly returned home, later to relocate to Newark, NJ where he pursued a career as a tailor and later as a chef.

In 1952, Marvin married the love of his life Dorothy Young and to this union four children were born. This union created a bond that lasted over sixty-five years.

Marvin's career as a Chef led him to work at Christ Hospital, Jersey City, NJ, United Presbyterian Hospital, Newark, NJ, Kean University, formerly Newark State College, Union, NJ and Newark Renaissance House, Newark, NJ. His culinary skills were greatly appreciated especially at the family gatherings where he was the grill master.

Marvin was a loving and affectionate husband, father and grandfather who cherished the time spent with his family. He also enjoyed coaching little league, traveling, watching and attending baseball games, playing pool, cooking, and storytelling. One of his greatest enjoyments, besides watching Westerns, was being an Usher at the New Hope Baptist Church, Newark, NJ until his health declined.
