Pansy worked as a bookkeeper at Salem Community Center in Harlem, NY and later was employed with Bank of America as a teller and retired with over 20 years of service as a customer service rep. Her slogan was “You and your money should be happy!”

Pansy was a faithful member of Trinity Episcopal Church of Montclair where she held the position of bookkeeper; member of the Women’s Club, Volunteer Club, and Outreach program where she got her opportunity to once again connect with the community—providing groceries, clothing, or words of inspiration to those in need.
