## Reflections of Life

*Sis. Rochelle Alice Green* was born on September 18, 1958 in Newark, New Jersey to the late Arvetrus and Cleotha Green. At an early age, the family moved to Linden. Rochelle received the majority of her elementary and secondary education in Linden Public Schools. She attended Kean University and Union County College and received a Bachelor of Business Administration from American Intercontinental University with Summa Cum Laude honors. Rochelle was a member of Heard A.M.E. Church in Roselle under the Pastorate of Rev. Stephen A. Green and a former member of Union Chapel A.M.E. Church under the Pastorate of Rev. Anthony Mitchell, Jr.

Rochelle was the current Financial Manager at the Elizabeth Coalition to House the Homeless in Elizabeth. Previously, she was employed with the United Way of Greater Union County for the past 25 years where she held the position of Vice President of Finance and Administration. In summary, Rochelle was responsible for the direction and execution of all finance and administrative related functions of the organization. She also served as the Fiscal Officer for Union Chapel Community Development Corporation, Treasury of the New Jersey Conference Lay Organization, was the current President of the Roselle Section of the National Council of Negro Women, and a member of the Leadership Newark Class of 2014. Prior to that, Rochelle was a Church Accountant for a number of years at Heard A.M.E. Church. In addition at Heard, she served on the Stewardess Board #2, Treasurer of Heard A.M.E. Lay Organization, Senior Usher Board, Louise Wilson Womens Missionary Society, member of the Emergency Choir and was a member of the Credit Committee for the Heard A.M.E. Federal Credit Union. Rochelle was a licensed New Jersey Life Insurance Producer, a Notary commissioned in the State of New Jersey and the Proprietor of Green Financial Services.

Rochelle worked extensively with various community based organizations in the Eastern Union County area. She developed and provided oversight for fiduciary


*arrangements with the NAACP as Treasurer in Roselle, Roselle Collaborative for Youth and Families, the Greater Elizabeth Adolescent Partnership, the Jefferson Roselle Park Family Success Centers. In May of 2013, Rochelle was honored with a "Community Vision Award" by the Roselle Collaborative for Youth and Families where she received a citation from former Mayor of Roselle Jamel C. Holley (now Assemblyman) and Senator Raymond J. Lesniak of the New Jersey Legislature.*

*She enjoyed working and being a part of community building endeavors and programs that help to connect people with noteworthy programs such as those administered by Union Chapel Community Development Corporation. The true measure of greatness is not how much others have done for you but how much you have been able to serve others. Ultimately, this is what Union Chapel's CDC is about is it is what Rochelle continually strived to do. Ms. Green loved serving others and played a role in delivering services that improve the quality of life for all. She was a leadership Newark Fellow and a huge advocate for leaders of the 21st century.*

*On Tuesday, December 24, 2019, she departed this earthly life. Rochelle was predeceased by her brother, Salik A. "Thurston" Green.*

*Rochelle leaves to cherish her memories and legacy, her son, Waymon Green of Linden, New Jersey; sister, Donna Green; two brothers: Walter and Trevor Green; six nieces: Jamila Green, Allison Wallace, Nayirah Coney, Samiyah, Cheyenne and Brianna Green; nephew; Kevin Slaughter; aunt, Beatrice Thomas; sister-in-law, Talisha Slaughter Green; and all of the family were a big part of her life.
