## **OBITUARY**

Fitz Maurice Winston JACOBS

Fitz Maurice (known as Maurice), was born on August 28th, 1943, at Ketley Street, Georgetown, Guyana. He was the third child of the late Cyril and Gertrude Jacobs.

His father, Cyril, was at the time, employed by the then Berbice Bauxite Company in Kwakwani. Gertrude and her brood, of Norma, Lionel and Maurice joined Cyril November 1943, in Kwakwani. Maurice, was the youngest child in Kwakwani, along with five others, at the time.

Maurice attended Mt. Oliver Lutheran School, where he excelled and later went on to attend Victoria High School in New Amsterdam. He was an active participant in the Cubs and Scouts in Kwakwani and was also a server for many years at the St. James Greater Kwakwani, Church of England Parish church. His father was the Catechist, who managed the Parish then.

He was very fond of animals, and along with many loved dogs, had a pet monkey called Jimmy. One of his favorite dogs was Bonzo. He was a very caring and attentive owner.

In 1958, Cyril retired from his position in Kwakwani, and the family moved and settled at Foulis Paradise, East Coast Demerara. Maurice eventually pursued an apprenticeship with Guysuco, which led to his completing his City and Guilds in Electrical Engineering. He went on to attain Managerial status with the Electricity Corporation in his adult years. He completed several courses abroad in England/Europe as he furthered his career.

He migrated to the US in 1983 and years later became employed with the New York Transit as a supervisor until his retirement.

He is survived by his children, Roshleigh Buck, Evanson Curtis Jacobs, Karen Jacobs Defreitas, Shalimar Smith, Melissa Jacobs D'Avilar, and the late Avery Jacobs and Quacey Jacobs.
