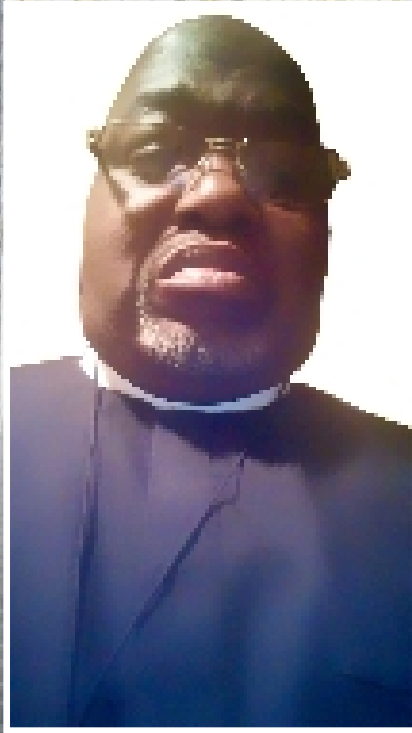

Pastor Prentiss McRae, Sr. was born on April 14, 1955 in Bennettsville, South Carolina, the son of Margaret McRae and the late Otis McRae. He was educated in the Newark Public School system and later graduated from Eastern Bible Institute.

In 1980, Pastor McRae accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and personal savior. He became a devoted member of Mt. Zion F. B. H. Church in Linden, New Jersey under the leadership of the late Pastor M. W. Steele where he served as an Ordained Deacon. In 1985, God elevated him to the Pastoral Office at Mt. Zion F.B.H. Church where he served faithfully until his transition.

Pastor McRae served in many capacities locally and enjoyed district functions. He was appointed head of the Evangelistic Board in the New Jersey District.

In 1981, he was united in holy matrimony to Daisy Johnson and remained married for 38 years. With this union, they were blessed with four children: Prentiss Jr., Carnell, Latoya and Jasmine.
